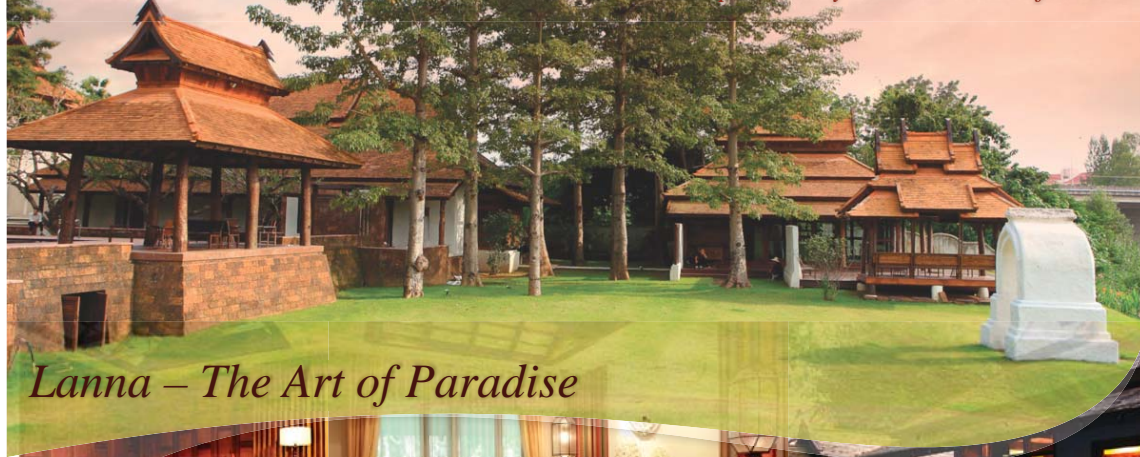
**Final journey for Blue Mountains Scenic Railway**
